Sun Clinical Laboratories is now contracted with PerkinElmer to perform cfDNA (aka NIPT) testing for all pregnant women throughout the state of California!

What this means

Beginning in March 2023, PerkinElmer & Sun Lab will be certified for the California Prenatal Screening Program and listed as an option for all providers to select to perform NIPT testing services. Choosing PerkinElmer would have the maternal blood sample sent to our laboratory in El Monte where tests would be performed in-house using a PerkinElmer platform.

Patient Information

Soon-to-be mothers **will not** need any special preparation (e.g. fasting, off medication, etc.) the day they get their blood drawn. All they need to do is bring the physician's order form along with their ID and insurance cards directly to any Sun Lab location; no appointments necessary!

Once there, the patient will check-in at the reception desk and have their paperwork verified. Upon verification, a service fee will be charged and their blood drawn. All final results will be sent to their provider within 5-10 business days.

Provider Information

All healthcare providers ordering cfDNA testing through the CA Prenatal Screening Program will need to create an account on the state program's website. This will grant access to the patient results portal, electronic test ordering, and testing supplies request. Please be sure to correctly fill out the order form for each patient to prevent delays in testing. Then, select PerkinElmer/Sun Lab as the designated testing facility on the order. Provide the patient with the order confirmation sheet and instruct them to bring it to any Sun Lab draw station.

When test results are finalized, they will be uploaded to the state portal where they can be viewed/printed and discussed between the physician and the patient.
